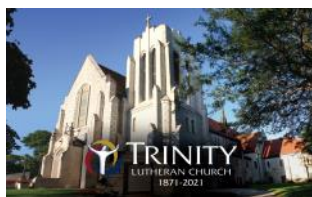

A few years ago, I attended the funeral of a former teacher of mine. He was a marvelous man whose wisdom, humor and compassion made an enormous impact on my life. I was deeply sad to lose him.

His funeral was a marvelous celebration – one of those gatherings I like to call, “a good funeral.” The preacher shared memories but also spoke clearly and powerfully of Christ’s resurrection promise. Friends and former students of my teacher gave heartfelt eulogies. The music was well-chosen and heavy on congregational songs. (There is nothing better than singing together at funerals, I think.) After burial and a meal, family and friends stuck around the church to reconnect and tell stories. It was sad and wonderful. A very good funeral.

The death of a loved one is a time of profound grief and sorrow. It is also a time when our faith and faith community can offer great comfort. Trinity, as a congregation, has long cherished this kind of ministry. From end-of-life to funeral and grief/loss support, we see these ministries as a way to share God’s healing love with members and non-members alike.

Funeral Meals and Radical Hospitality

Ten years ago, Trinity created funeral serving teams of both men and women to continue the funeral lunch ministry once provided by TLC’s women’s circles. This new ministry has been an enormous success. Families and guests at funerals regularly comment on the compassion of these meal teams. And many volunteers love their time together. “We have so much fun,” one recently shared. Team members are “on” for a month at a time, and only serve when they are able. Mary Charlson, who has led this ministry since its beginning, recently passed the baton to Ellie Koester and a group of other leaders. If you would like to get involved, contact Ellie or the church office. It’s such a powerful ministry.

Trinity’s Columbarium

The landscaping on Trinity’s columbarium is nearly complete. There is now a concrete pad around the structure, flower planters, a newly planted tulip tree nearby, and a new bench on the way. A number of inurnments have already taken place and about a third of the existing niches are already reserved. The west side of the columbarium is a memorial wall. This allows those who are (or will be) buried elsewhere to have their names inscribed on the structure. Interested in learning more? Contact the office or one of the pastors.

Prayers and Support

We pray regularly for those in our community who have lost loved ones – in worship, in Bible studies and through our prayer teams. Sometimes our greatest need for support comes months or even years after a loss. Grief support groups and bereavement ministry through cards, calls and visits are another way we care at TLC. If you know someone who could use help, invite them to reach out to staff member, friend or grief specialist in our community. Or ask permission to call us on their behalf.

Everyone experiences loss and death. Jesus knew this and promised us comfort. Thank you for sharing this important ministry at Trinity!†

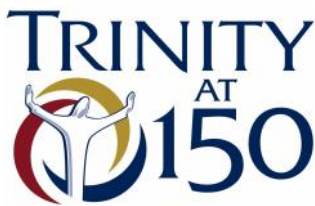

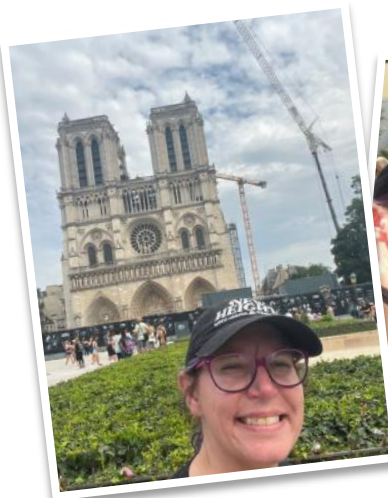

FROM THE FRENCH QUARTER TO FRANCE

Perhaps it was a crazy idea to go from New Orleans and the French Quarter with our youth to attending the Olympics in Paris, France. A crazy good idea. One of the things that really spoke to me during both trips was the sense of community. How so many are gathered together to celebrate. While both communities were wildly different, there were many great connectors.

Through both experiences, I had the opportunity to make new friends...whether it was youth leaders from other ELCA churches, or being adopted by the parents of the New Zealand women's soccer (football) team. A great gem of a quote came from one of the team dads, Ian Foster (the former All-Blacks coach), who told me that he supposed it was fine that I moved from California to Iowa because Jesus told me to do it. And that I went from a youth event of 16,000 people to a rugby match with 70,000 in attendance. Between the two weeks, I walked 84.02 miles, or in Olympic terms, 90 Leducky swims. This historic event has been a part of our community of faith even before the ELCA was formed in the 1980s. Speakers from Dr. King, to Archbishop Desmond Tutu have spoken at past events, and this year featured amazing people as well.

Every 3 years, the ELCA brings together youth from across the globe to attend the Gathering in their selected city of choice. Over the decades, the event has adapted to meet the ever changing

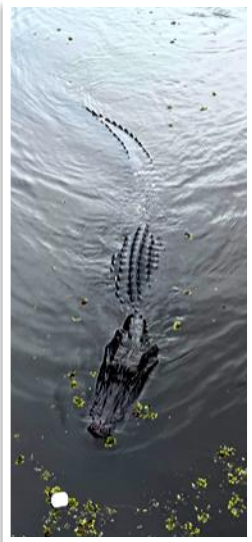

needs of the population this ministry of the ELCA serves, mainly our youth ages 14-18. For the 2024 event in New Orleans, Trinity teamed up with a number of other NEIA churches to attend together.

Our trek started out with a very merry bus ride overnight through the Midwest and Arkansas. Chicken biscuits, lattes, and more fueled our bus conversations as we continued into Louisiana, where we arrived for our first night together. 16,000 attendees gathered nightly in the Smoothie King Center, home of the Pelicans NBA team for worship, speakers, and fun together.

Our next day was our day of fun in the bayou. We kicked off by packing sack lunches to fuel us between our activities, and then headed out on the road for our pontoon boat tour of the bayou. We had a great guide who helped introduce us to a number of local swamp friends. Who knew that gators were so in love with marshmallows? We also



was to do so through numerous storms and rain showers throughout the week, which led us to deviate plans a few times. Those changes led us to discovering a great pizza place, splashing through many waterlogged streets, and taking some extra time to hang out in the Community Life and Interactive learning areas.

The rain did break for us to be able to complete our project for our Accompaniment day, where we worked with a local community garden and outreach center. We weeded, prepped mulch, worked in sheds, and saved a snail.

Our last full day included being able to worship with more of our Region 5 friends, including churches from all over Iowa. We played a get to know you bingo game, had worship and communion together, and then joined a number of churches from NEIA, as well as Bishop Kevin on a paddle wheeler journey. Our time together came to a close during our final worship service, where we all joined together to celebrate and share communion before the announcement for the next Gathering was announced. 2027's experience will be held in Minneapolis, which is an exciting place to be able to be in community again.

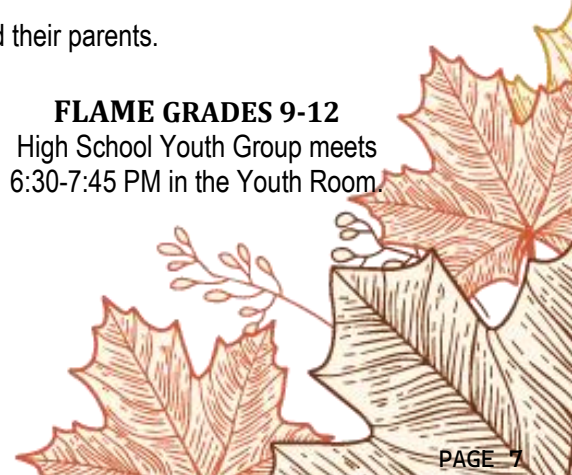

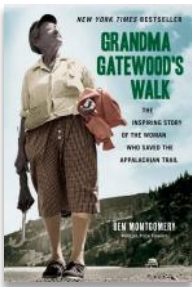

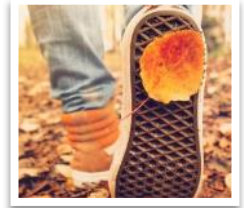

BLOOD PRESSURE CHECKS RETURN

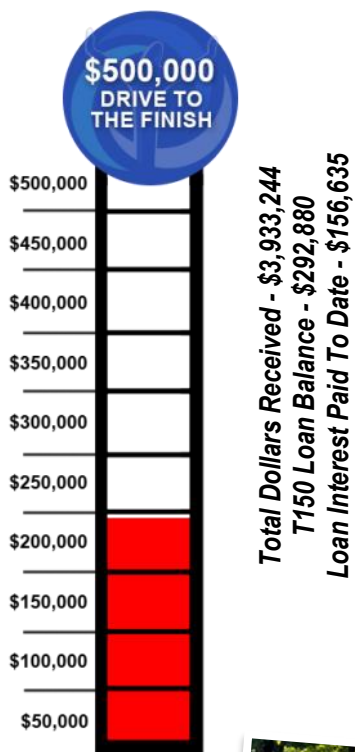
